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General Requirements for foreign guest tattooists working temporarily in Malta within a licensed premises

1. Application for a licence – duly filled and signed.
2. Company details or details of the owner of the business premises where the guest tattooist will be operating from.
3. A copy of the business licence of the premises where the guest tattooist will be operating from.
4. Copy of applicant's ID card / passport.
5. Hepatitis B Vaccination Course (3 vaccinations) and Anti HbS blood test of applicant taken eight weeks post vaccination.
6. A copy of the Memorandum of Articles or ID Card of the business owner.
7. Copy of Certificate of Training and course transcript.
Training should cover all areas specified in the established standards for safe and hygienic practice and must reference the European Qualification Framework (EQF level 4) to ensure that training is uniform and of equivalent quality.
8. Copy of licence possessed by the guest tattooist issued in any other country and name of the awarding competent or licensing authority or accreditation body.
9. If the applicant is not an EU resident, a work permit is required.
10. A copy of the endorsed engagement form by Jobsplus
